hereunder shall be subject to all the Jerms and conditions (which are hereby incorporated by reference and have the same force and effect as if the same were severally, fully and specifically set forth herein).

1. approved by the Canadian Transport Commission for Canada by General Order No. T-5, dated February 1, 1965 set forth in the Canadian Freight Classification and also available at all Railway agency stations and freight of-

4. of the bill of lading form R.T. 200, approved by the Quebec Transportation Board on August 5, 1980, when the said goods originating in Quebec are to be carried by a motor carrier;

5. or approved by the Canadian Transport Commission for Canada by General Order No. T-43, set forth in the Rules for the Carriage of Express and Non-Carload Freight Traffic and also available at all express and railway agency stations and express and freight offices upon request, when said goods are carried by a rail carrier; and which are agreed by the shipper and accepted for himself and his assigns.
